1 Phylogenetic History: The Evolution of Marine Mammals

Evolutionary lineages are shown as branches on a tree diagram with the living taxa as leaves at the tips of the branches The root of the tree is the common ancestor Each node where two branches diverge shows a speciation event where one ancestral lineage diverged into two independent lineages

Background Information : A cladogram is a diagram that shows evolutionary relationships among groups It is based on phylogeny, which is the study of evolutionary relationships In the past, biologists would group organisms based solely on their physical appearance Today, with the advances in genetics

Selection as an evolutionary force • Hardy-Weinberg null model assumptions • Individuals of all genotypes survive at equal rates, and contribute gametes equally to the gene pool • Bottom line is differential reproductive success: some genotypes out reproduce others
